UNBC Undergraduate Admission Requirements:

Minimum Requirement:

GCE: a minimum of two Advanced (A) level subjects and three Ordinary (O) level subjects, must be completed with an overall grade point average of C or higher in order to be considered for admission. All A level subjects presented for admission must have a grade of at least C. Students may substitute two Advanced-Subsidiary (AS) level subjects for one A-level.

Malawi School Certificate of Education / Cambridge Overseas School Certificate (COSC): Minimum of five Credit passes in English, three academics and one elective for general entry.
