## UNBC Undergraduate Admission Requirement s:

### Minimum Requirement :

x GCE: a minimum of two Advanced (A) level subjects and three Ordinary (O) level subjects, must be completed with an overall grade point average of C or higher in order to be considered for admission. All A level subjects presented for admission must have a grade of at least C. Students may substitute two Advanced-Subsidiary (AS) level subjects for one A-level.

### Transfer Applicants:

x To be considered a transfer student, a minimum of 15 credit hours of acceptable university-level course work from a recognized post-secondary institution. Please ensure WR SURYLGH \RXU VF KPRE&SO \$P#: https://www.unif-co.oredit-definitions

### Recommendations and Comments:

Upon receipt of paid application (<u>www.unbc.ca/apply</u>), applicants will receive an acknowledgement letter by email which outlines what documents we require to make a decision on their application. You are welcome to provide us with emailed copies of your transcripts/mark sheets, but we will require official copies prior to the start of your classes. To be considered official, the documents must come to us directly in a sealed envelope from your school/institution or testing agency.
