To receive the Diploma in Social Service Worker (Co-ordinated), students must successfully complete the Certificate in Social Service Worker and a minimum 30 credits^ including a minimum 24 credits of university-transferable³ courses that have science, social science, or humanities attributes, and 6 credits of any course eligible to be used towards a Langara College credential.

Unless students transfer in courses earned before they began the Social Service Worker program, they must complete the 30 credits at Langara. Refer to Co-ordinated Programs information for details.
