New and Young Workers

- New and young workers are those deemed to be under the age of 25, new to the company, or new to the task being performed
- These workers must be given workplace instruction and remain under the guidance of a competent supervisor

Permits

 Safe Work Permits are mandatory for all work conducted on UNBC property and must be obtained prior

Parking

Vehicles shall be parked in designated parking spots. Note, paid parking is in effective on the UNBC Campus and at the Northern Sports Centre 24hours per day, 7 days per week. Do not park on, without prior arrangement:

- University roadways
- Emergency or fire lanes
- Any area not clearly marked as a parking stall

Service passes are available through Facilities Management.

Any vehicle which is improperly parked and/or parked in one of the designated parking stalls or special spaces without displaying a proper parking permit or pass will be subject to a parking citation and/or towing.

Contractors that do not show due diligence in enforcing the safety rules and OH&S regulations with their employees may face cancellation of their contract with UNBC.
